Entry Exams	Only if required; otherwise direct admission via document evaluation
Additional Requirements	Passport copy, Health certificate, Police clearance certificate (if applicable)

### 3. Admission Policy

Admission Type	Direct admission based on document verification
Application Submission	Online via KIET international portal / SII portal through registered counsellors
Document Verification	Academic transcripts, passport, English proficiency, recommendation letters
Seat Confirmation	Provisional admission upon document verification; final admission after fee payment
Intake Periods	April to July

#### Process Flow:

1. Application submission via KIET International Portal or SII portal.
2. Verification of academic and identity documents.
3. Issue of provisional admission letter.
4. Payment of fees confirms final admission.
5. Visa assistance and pre-departure support by IRO/ International Admissions Cell.
6. Orientation and onboarding of international students.
